



Artist Information 2023

The Sixth Annual Boerne BierFest kicks off Saturday, September 23rd, with General Admission from 1pm - 6pm, and a VIP Experience offered from Noon -1pm, and Meet and Greet with Gary P. Nunn at 6pm. The AgriCultural Museum and Arts Center, located at 102 City Park Road, Boerne, Texas 78006, is again the venue for this year's event.

Proceeds:

Proceeds benefit local arts organizations through grants awarded by the Hill Country Council for the Arts (HCCArts). HCCArts is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization.

Entry Fees:

Early Bird Fee \$75, through July 31st. After August 1st, \$125 Fee applies. Final Deadline for payment of Fees, September 5th, to be included in collateral marketing materials. Fees are non-refundable.

FIRST-TIME participants to Boerne BierFest are **JURIED**, UNLESS you have exhibited at BierFest or Art Waddle in the last two years. E-mail sample images of your recent artwork to Paula Horner, president@hccarts.org. You will be notified within 48 hours of your acceptance. Make check or money order payable to: HCCArts, and mail to HCCArts/Boerne BierFest, P.O. Box 2024, Boerne TX 78006. Your Application can also be e-mailed to president@hccarts.org to indicate your Boerne BierFest artwork entry.

Eligible Media:

Prints and Giclées are permitted, but a minimum of 65% of the exhibited artwork must be original artwork. To enter your artwork, it must fall into one, or more, of the following Fine Arts or Applied Arts categories:

Application:

No commercial side products are allowed. Applicants must be 18 years of age or older to apply.

Staff Support:

Staff will be present on-site throughout the entire Boerne BierFest schedule of events Saturday, Contact information will be posted.

Set-up:

Artists can set up Friday with advance approval of Art Market Director, Paula Horner. Send request to president@hccarts.org, or call 210-269-8349. Saturday set-up will begin at 7am - 9am. Boerne BierFest will open PROMPTLY at Noon for VIP Experience. Vehicles must be moved from loading area by 11am. Tear down begins at 7pm on Saturday. Absolutely no early staging of cars and trailers will be allowed due to business operations.

Artists' Body of Work:

Artists will be judged on the entire body of work exhibited, Saturday morning. Best in Show, 1st in Fine Arts and 1st in Applied Arts, 2nd, 3rd and two Honorable Mention ribbons will be awarded. The Best in Show recipient will be given the opportunity to have their artwork featured on next year's Boerne BierFest limited edition art poster.



Artist's Equipment:

We suggest all Artists have a canopy since areas may not be fully shaded, along with the necessary tables and chairs for their booths. Artists are responsible for bringing any equipment necessary to display their art along with appropriate tie downs or weights (25lbs per leg suggested).

ATMs:

ATMs will be available at Boerne BierFest for the Artists' convenience.

Port-a-Pots:

Facilities will be located on the event footprint in addition to the Boerne BierFest fixed public bathroom locations.

Pets:

Please leave all the animals at home.

Badges:

Artists will be given badges with lanyards for participant identification and entry into the Artists' areas.

Security:

Police will be available if required for an emergency on Saturday. No security is being provided on Friday night. If you wish to setup your tents, tables, and chairs we cannot be responsible for them. Boerne BierFest and affiliates, merchants, the Hill Country Council for the Arts, and the City of Boerne accept no liability for any reason monetarily or otherwise for Artists' equipment, artworks – original or reproduced, vehicles, etc. By signing this application, the Artist named below holds harmless all organizations and individuals affiliated with the Boerne BierFest for any reason. You also agree to allow the event the use of any pictures of artwork or individuals for use in promotional material media relative to the event.
